Logic of Specialization

- The specialization (Module C) starts in the 2nd semester and continues during the 3rd and 4th semester.
- Module C courses are elective irrespective of which specialization was previously declared.
- There are Module C courses where students can collect 3 or 6 or 9 ECTS depending on the rules set by the lecturer.
- Students have to collect 18 ECTS points in total within Module C.
- Logic:
 - During the 1st year (2nd semester), each student has to collect 6 ECTS.
 - During the 2nd year (3rd and 4th semesters), each student has to collect 12 ECTS.
- Language courses cannot be recognized as module C courses.

AMU additional important information

- Students have to collect 54 ECTS in the 1st year and 66 ECTS in the 2nd year.
- In case a student collects less than 54 ECTS in the 1st year and less than 66 ECTS in the 2nd year, s/he is required to apply for an exemption (section 34 of the AMU study regulations) at the AMU student office (monika.bak@amu.edu.pl) or in the USOS-System to continue their studies with a possibility to retake the missing courses (up to 3 courses).
